As you can see there is a comprehensive plan of activities that include: tutors delivering sessions during Character Education; online tasks delivered through Unifrog—a careers package; assemblies given by senior leaders and external visitors; and workshops given by external providers, either on site or where students visit workplaces.

We also give our Year 10s and 11s the opportunity to undertake work experience and have 1:1 interviews with the Careers Lead (Mr Minns), the Head of Next Steps (Ms Mastracci) and an external adviser from 4YP.
