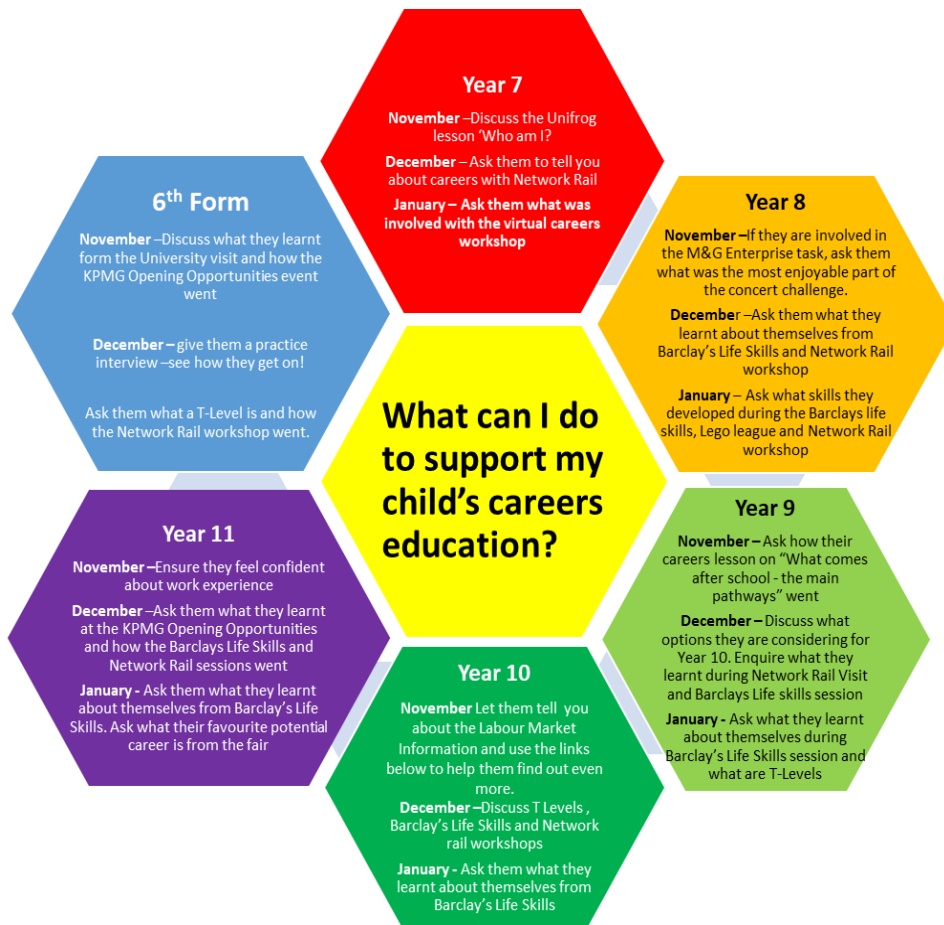


The Talent Foundry — M&G Enterprise Challenge. Year 8 STEM Workshop
